PLEASE NOTE: As much as we want to include religious material, sometimes they inspect, and entire shipments can be refused if it is religious. This applies more to international but it's one of the rules of operation. Each kit costs around \$5 depending upon where you buy. Big Lots, Family Dollar Store, Dollar Tree, 99 Cent Stores are best. You are welcome to donate an entire kit or individual items.

BRING KITS OR INDIVIDUAL ITEMS TO:

- ▶ Table in the church courtyard on Sundays, 9/10 & 9/17
- ▶ Box in the Church Office no later than WED. 9/20/17

ITEMS NEEDED – PLEASE FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

- ▶ **1 gallon strong ziplock bags** (Slider lock prevents it from opening.)
- ▶ **Washcloth** (Don't buy the cheapest. Remember the tender skins that will use them. Best price and quality is Tuesday Morning at 6/\$3.99)
- ▶ **Small tissue packet**
- ▶ **Comb**
- ▶ **Bar of soap**
- ▶ **Waterless anti-bacterial sanitizer** (If it doesn't say waterless, read the directions. If it says to rinse afterward, it isn't waterless. This is critical because water supply is often polluted or non-existent. If you buy little ones, we need to put two inside.)
- ▶ **Toothbrush - MOST NEEDED ITEM** (Do not buy the packs with multiple brushes. We have to split them apart which isn't sanitary. The really good bargains are tempting but have bristles that are loose and dangerous for children to use.)
- ▶ **Toothpaste** (small to medium sized)
- ▶ **Beanie** (Stuffed animals (any brand) no larger than 6 inch size so they fit in the Ziplock bag. They are found at different times at Walgreens and any of the dollar type stores. Since these are staying in the U.S., any kind of animal is fine.)
