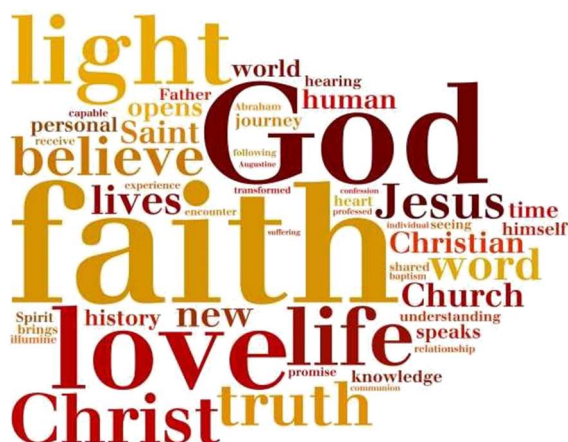
## Middle School Moments
