Friday, Feb. 28, 2020—3:00 p.m., Sanctuary

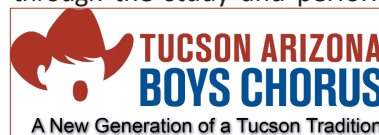
