Followers of Jesus are asked to “shine like stars” in a “crooked and perverse generation.”

Philippians 3:7-16

Suffering and loss invite us to press on toward the goal of full union and knowledge of Christ Jesus.

***“Do Not Worry”***  
Philippians 4:4-9

Rejoicing in all the ways God brings us through, and all God does for us, increases our ability to “not worry.”

***Palm & Passion Sunday – “Strengthened by Christ”***  
Philippians 4:10-14

In the famous passage – Philippians 4:13, “I can do all things through him who strengthens me” – we are reminded, as we go into Holy Week, that the strength Jesus showed throughout this week becomes our strength as we follow Him.

***Easter – “Love is ... Accepting New Life”***
