Do our roles make us or do we simply inhabit our roles? Our habits are more important than our titles. Amos invites us to a prophetic life lived fulfilling God’s call.

“Jeremiah: Looking for Good Shepherds”
Jeremiah 23:1-6; Psalm 23

What does it mean to be cared for by the Good Shepherd? God models caring for God’s people, but then invites us to operate in ways that reflect God’s care for the world.

“Elisha: More Than Enough”
2 Kings 4:42-44; Psalm 145:10-18
