Sunday, Oct. 2; by calling the church office, or just come to the south parking lot on Oct. 7 and order and pick up your meal.

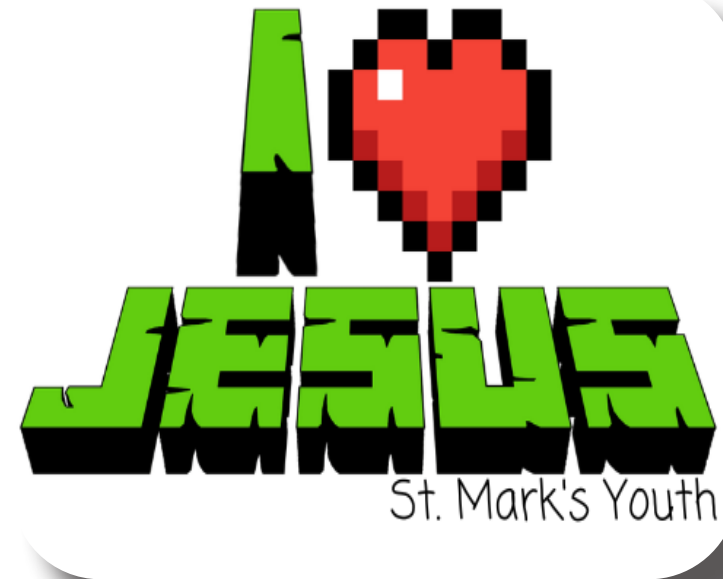
